

CAMP MAPLE LEAF PACKING/KIT CHECKLIST

HELPFUL HINTS:

- Label everything clearly and permanently if you don't label it, it will probably not make it home!
- Pack belongings in duffel bags and label with baggage tags to be stored in the bus. Campers must restrict their belongings to only two duffel bags maximum and one carry on.
- Snacks for the bus ride must be nut free. All leftover food will be taken upon arrival to camp, checked and all sealed items will be shared among the camp in programming.
- Do not send expensive clothing or equipment the camp is not responsible for loss, damage of any belongings in transit or at camp.
- Please make modifications as you wish.
